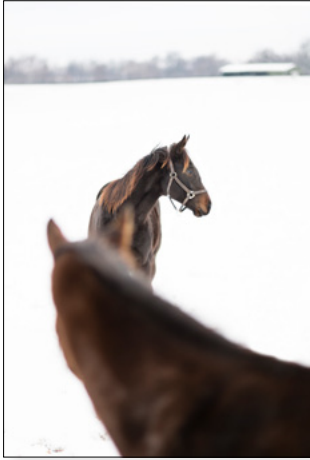

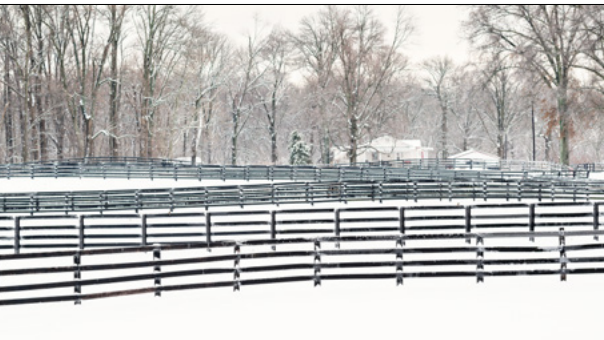
With a goal to **permanently protect and steward lands critical to agricultural viability and community character in the Bluegrass region**, Bluegrass Land Conservancy works on a daily basis with landowners across the region to conserve land through voluntary conservation easements.

In our 30 year history, BLC has worked to directly save nearly 34,000 of our most critical acres for future generations. Through partnerships and a long-term commitment to further conservation efforts, BLC has assisted in conserving 450 farms totaling over 65,000 acres across the Bluegrass. These lands will remain open for agricultural use and natural habitat in perpetuity. However, with one of the highest rates of farmland loss in the

country, Kentucky has lost nearly 800,000 acres of land in the last two decades. In order to mitigate this loss, we are focused on increasing the pace of conservation in Kentucky.

Earlier this year, BLC was awarded the largest combined grant in the country through the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPD). This program will bring over \$45.7 million into Kentucky, flowing directly to qualifying landowners in critical conservation areas. With your help, BLC can continue to focus on bringing these types of innovative conservation opportunities to the Bluegrass.

1995-2025

Bluegrass Land Conservancy (BLC) is formed by a group of landowners concerned with the rapid, sprawling growth happening in the central Bluegrass region. Their vision continues today through our direct mission to land conservation.

1995

The first conservation easement is completed by BLC. Mr. and Mrs. Bob Wilson protected their 190-acre historic farm, The Judge Place, in Jessamine County, setting the stage for a new age of land conservation in the Bluegrass.

1998

BLC establishes the Fayette County Purchase of Development Rights (PDR) Program, which will receive local funding to conserve farmland, eventually resulting in more than 31,000 acres of land in Fayette County to date.

1999

BLC becomes the first non-profit Land Trust in Kentucky to directly conserve more than 10,000 acres of farmland and natural lands. This milestone sets the stage for continued increases to the pace of conservation.

2008

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission recognizes BLC as a land trust meeting the highest national standards for excellence and conservation permanence, naming BLC as the first nationally accredited land trust in Kentucky.

2013

BLC merges with Limestone Land Trust to create the largest regional land trust in Kentucky. The merger combines years of experience and expertise in Central Kentucky with the long-time passion, vision, and need for conservation in the Louisville Region.

First non-profit Land Trust in Kentucky to procure funds for landowners through the Federal NRCS easement program. Since this time, BLC has brought more than \$6.4 million in federal dollars and \$12.8 million in conservation value to Kentucky farm owners.

BLC is recognized as one of the top three accredited land trusts in the nation! Of accredited land trusts in the country, BLC ranks third for land conserved per year for an organization with 10, or fewer, staff members — all thanks to the hard work of our small but mighty team.

Awarded two federal program grants, totaling more than \$45 million that will go directly to Kentucky landowners. This was the largest combined award in the country for this program and is a testament to the reputation and quality work of BLC.

BLC began working through the federal program and gained support from the Kentucky General Assembly to help expand operations to bring the federal dollars to Kentucky landowners. This once in a generation program is expected to conserve more than 20,000 acres of land!
